- ▶ Bill: I grew up in the Detroit area. Dad was a fisherman and took me with him some of the time.
- ▶ Dave: Detroit is a long way from San Diego.

I had two different jobs in San Diego and retired again in 2001. We have lived in Rancho Bernardo for 24 years.

***Specie:** designate the kind of bass, trout, catfish, salmon, tuna, etc.

Club Sponsored Trips are those organized at club meetings by Club Officers/appointed Chairpersons at which members sign-up to participate in the trip.

For purposes of Club records& awards, there shall be only two classes as follows:

Class 1: All fish caught in fresh water or salt bodies of water by members on *Club Sponsored Trips* anywhere in the world providing said Specie is "a legal catch" from water where caught. ***Fish caught in saltwater on troll do not qualify.***

Class 2: Same as for *Class 1* except trip *Not Club Sponsored.*

Trophy Awards: There shall be only four (4) as follows:

Fresh Water Salt Water

Largest fish caught during the year Class 1 Yes Yes

Largest fish caught during the year Class 2 Yes Yes

Club Specie Record: Club Historian shall record all Specie certificates submitted *if it is the first for that Specie.*

Any current Specie Record shall be deleted & replaced by a new Specie certificate that shows a larger weight. Thus, it is so recorded & there shall be **NO** Trophy.
