SAE OUTLOOK

Lake Dixon has given the community some great trout fishing this year. In addition to 3 trout being caught over 16 pounds, the new lake record was set at 16.41 pounds. Fishing for catfish is in full swing. Night fishing is available on Thursday's and Friday's until 11:45 PM. Catfish will be stocked on July 14, July 21, August 4 and August 18. Lake Wohlford has also been stocked with catfish.

As for salt water fishing, the half-day boats are reporting good catches of calico bass, with 2/3 being released because of size. An occasional halibut is also being caught. The three-quarter day boats are doing well with sand bass and the majority are coming back with 50 to 70 yellowtail per trip. Most one day boats are returning with the limits of yellow tail. The day and a half boats are catching limits of yellowtail, but the bite is not as wide open as it was last month although the fish are bigger. As the water continues to warm, the shorter trips should continue to do better and better.

A SAE catfish challenge was recently held at Lake Dixon. **Hank and Janet Skaja** provided a outstanding picnic for the fisherman. Thanks to **Tony Smock** for making arrangements for boats, shelter and the challenge. Oh yes, **Tony** also won the challenge.
