

CAMPING TRIPS

Santee Lakes – January 31- February 4, 2022

Join us for the January Club Campout. We had such a good time last month, we have decided to return to Santee Lakes for four nights, checking in on January 31 and leaving February 4th.



The rate is \$60 a night plus tax for a total of \$66 a night. If you have a Good Sam Travel Membership you get 10% off, which covers the tax. If you do, make your reservations by phone at 619-596-3141. If you do not have a card you can book on line through their website www.santeelakes.com.

Because the refund policy for booking as a group does not allow a refund if you cancel less than 30 days in advance, and because you have to have at least 10 rigs to qualify for the group discount, we have decided everyone who wants to go will have to book their own site separately. If you book as an individual, you can cancel up to 48 hours in advance of your first night's stay.

This should be a good time to go since the Lakes will be stocking trout on the 28th.

SALTWATER

As most of you know, I have assumed the saltwater responsibilities previously handled by **Barbara Gattuso**. I will do my best to fill her shoes. Please be patient with me as I learn the position.

Based on the desires of the members, I will schedule our own saltwater trips if there is enough interest. I will also provide you with the opportunities to participate on trips of both the Rancho Bernardo Anglers and the Oceanside Senior Anglers.

Oceanside has scheduled a bottom fishing trip in both January and February. Since bottom fishing is closed in our waters for January and February, those trips will be going to Mexican waters. The January charter is set to depart on Monday, January 17 and return in the evening of Wednesday January 19, a two-day charter. They are scheduled to go to the Colonel Area. The cost is \$500 with visa and meals included. The February charter will be an overnight on the 7th and 8th and will cost \$252. Please contact **Jim Mauritz** for more information at 760-450-7060. Passports are required for these charters.

There is a possibility that the Rancho Bernardo Anglers will have an Ensenada bottom fishing trip on January 12 and February 9. This is a one-day trip on the Gamefisher out of Ensenada. Eight anglers are the limit on these trips. Anglers will meet at Brown Field in Otay Mesa at about 5-6 am on Jan.12 and about 8 pm on Feb. 9. Van transportation to Ensenada and back is provided. Passports and Mexican licenses are required. Contact **Frank Moton** at 858-220-0388 to make arrangements if you are interested. Several SAE members have gone on these trips previously.
