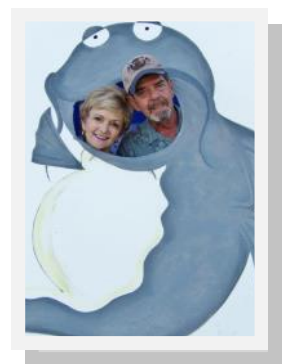
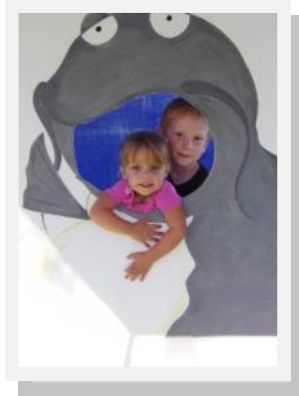
Don't miss the meeting this time as we hope to have all the photos of folks to take home who were eaten by a human size Catfish!

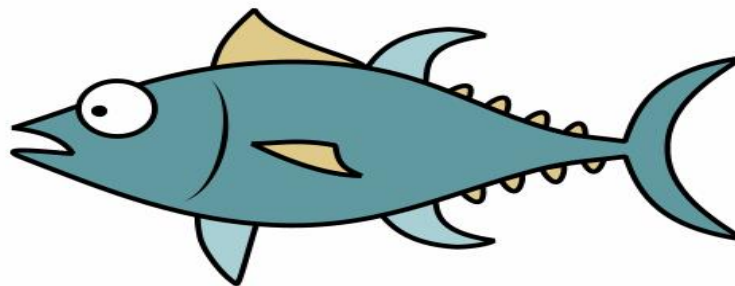
